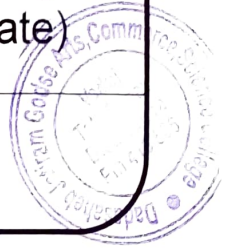

Initiated with Arts faculty, now the college is providing lessons in Commerce and Science Faculties also. In the present year, our HEI commenced P.G. in Commerce.

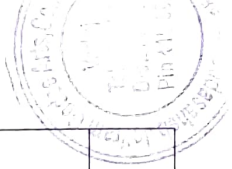
- 1 Creating sound educational infrastructure aimed at providing all-encompassing, socially enriching vocational education to the society and youth under the Institute's area of reach.

Com students) and Project Writing in the sixth semester (all Third Year BA and B. Com. And B. 5c. students). All B. A., B. Com. Studies as a part of the university prescribed syllabus. d 8. Sc. II students were asked to write Projects in Environment Studies as a part of the university prescribed syllabus.

Academic Calendar of the Institution:

Institutional Academic Calendar for the year 2022-23 was prepared by the committee for the same and was uploaded for the access of the stakeholders in the institution's website.

Introduction of NEP and Choice Base Credit system:

All courses across all programs on the campus, including B.A/ B.Com./ B.Sc.Part-I/ II/ III are under NEP and Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) pattern.

Student Satisfaction Survey: Feedback forms were online collected on google forms and also analyzed. In 2022-23, Student Satisfaction Survey were online conducted of B.A., B.Com and B.SC third year students. 388 students participated in the survey. Among them, 90 percent students were first time filling the feedback. In them 73.02% female students and 26.05 male students responded in the S.S.S. In Arts faculty, there were 36.2%, and in Commerce department, 53.00% were participated. And in science faculty 10.8% students responded to the questionnaire. Among them, 84.5% students' parents are in farming profession. 44.6% students' responded that 85 to 100% curriculum is completed. 26.2%

students responded that 70 to 84% curriculum is completed. 66.1% students agreed that 36.3% teachers are very impressive in teaching while 36.7% teachers are good at teaching 59.5% students agreed that Internal evaluation is always fair. 20.3% agreed that it is usually fair while 15.2% responded that it is sometimes unfair.

About the infrastructure, 33.8% students are strongly agree for infrastructure while 45.1 are agree and 16.9% are neutral. For the teaching and mentoring system, 27.3% students are significantly agree while 57.5% are very well and 11.00% are moderate.

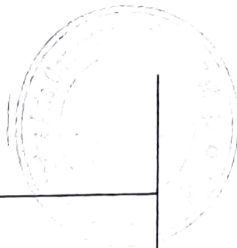

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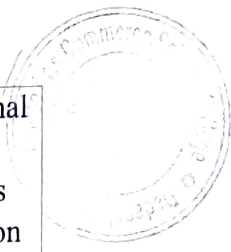
