Dadasaheb Jotiram Godse Arts, Commerce, Science College, Vaduj, in collaboration with International Science Community Association (ISCA) organized a two day "International Multi-disciplinary Conference on Science and Technology for Sustainable Development" (10th International Science Congress (ISC-2022)) on 8th and 9th December, 2022.

Dr. Kathryn Philip, University Librarian, Nigeria (Africa) and Prof. Sushila Devi Shrestha, Dept. of Botany, Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu, Nepal (Asia) attended and presented their deliberations in the conference as foreign delegates.

Delegates and research scholars from all over India attended the conference. Delegates and research scholars from Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Gujrat, Madhya Pradesh, Utter Pradesh, Haryana, West Bengal, Karnataka and Goa attended the conference and gave their Oral and Poster Presentation.



The conference was inaugurated on 8th December, 2022 at 10 AM by lighting the lamp of knowledge at the auspicious hands of Hon. Dr. P. S. Patil, Pro Vice-chancellor, Shivaji University, Kolhapur, Hon.
