Inauguration of Competitive Examination Center:

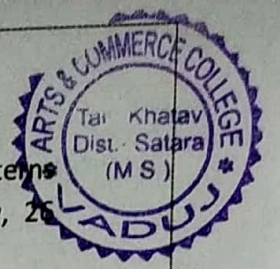





So far experiential and participative learning of students is concerned, the institution, as part of university assessment, introduced seminar in the fifth semester (all Third Year B. A. and B. 
